 - *Questionnaire form for vaccination records at health facility*
- Questionnaire for children aged 5–17 years (5 modules)

- Questionnaire for children aged 5–17 years
- New modules:
 - Employment (country-specific modul)
 - Material deprivation
 - Household energy use
 - Victimization
 - Informed decision-making on reproductive health
 - Child functioning
 - Parental involvement

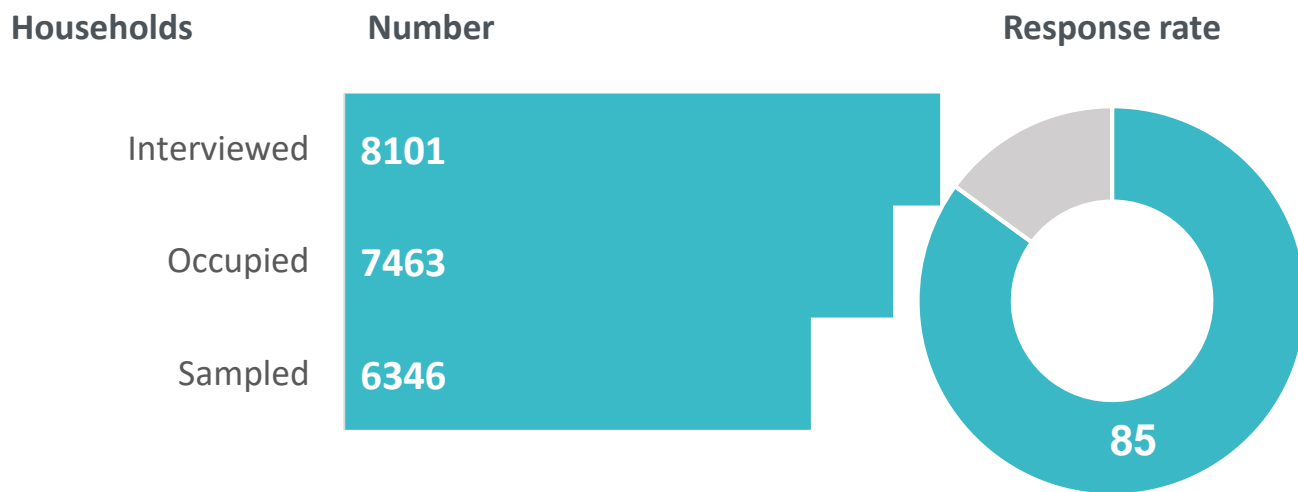

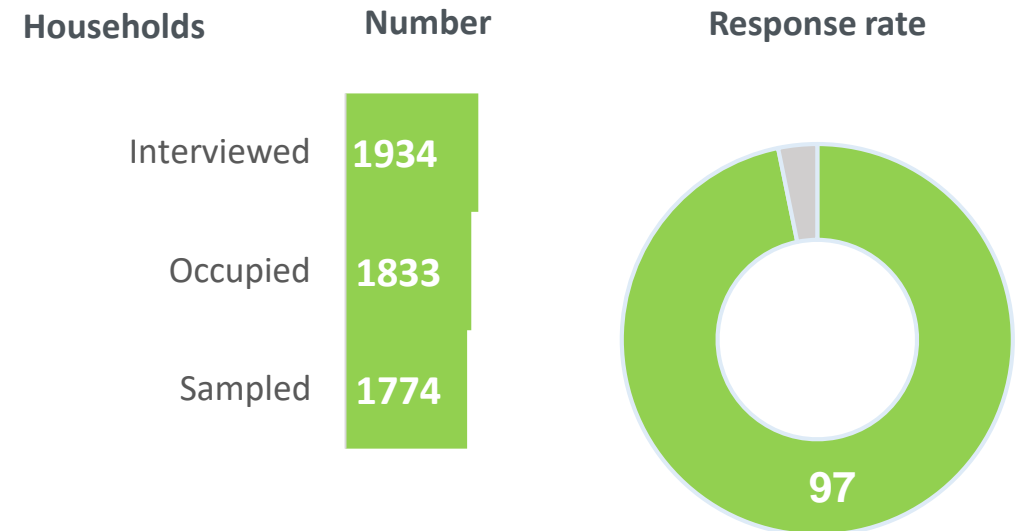

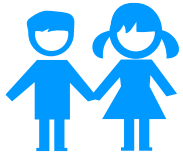

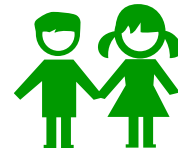

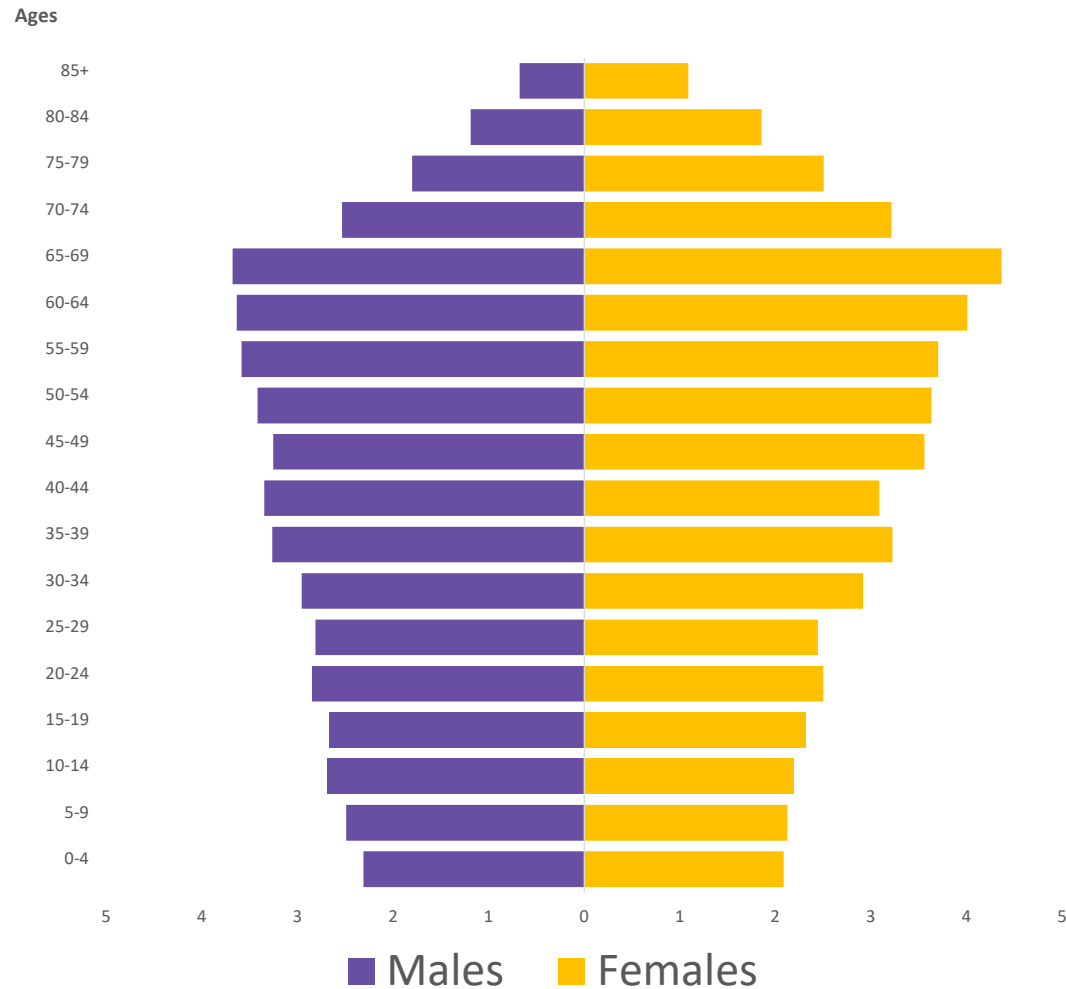

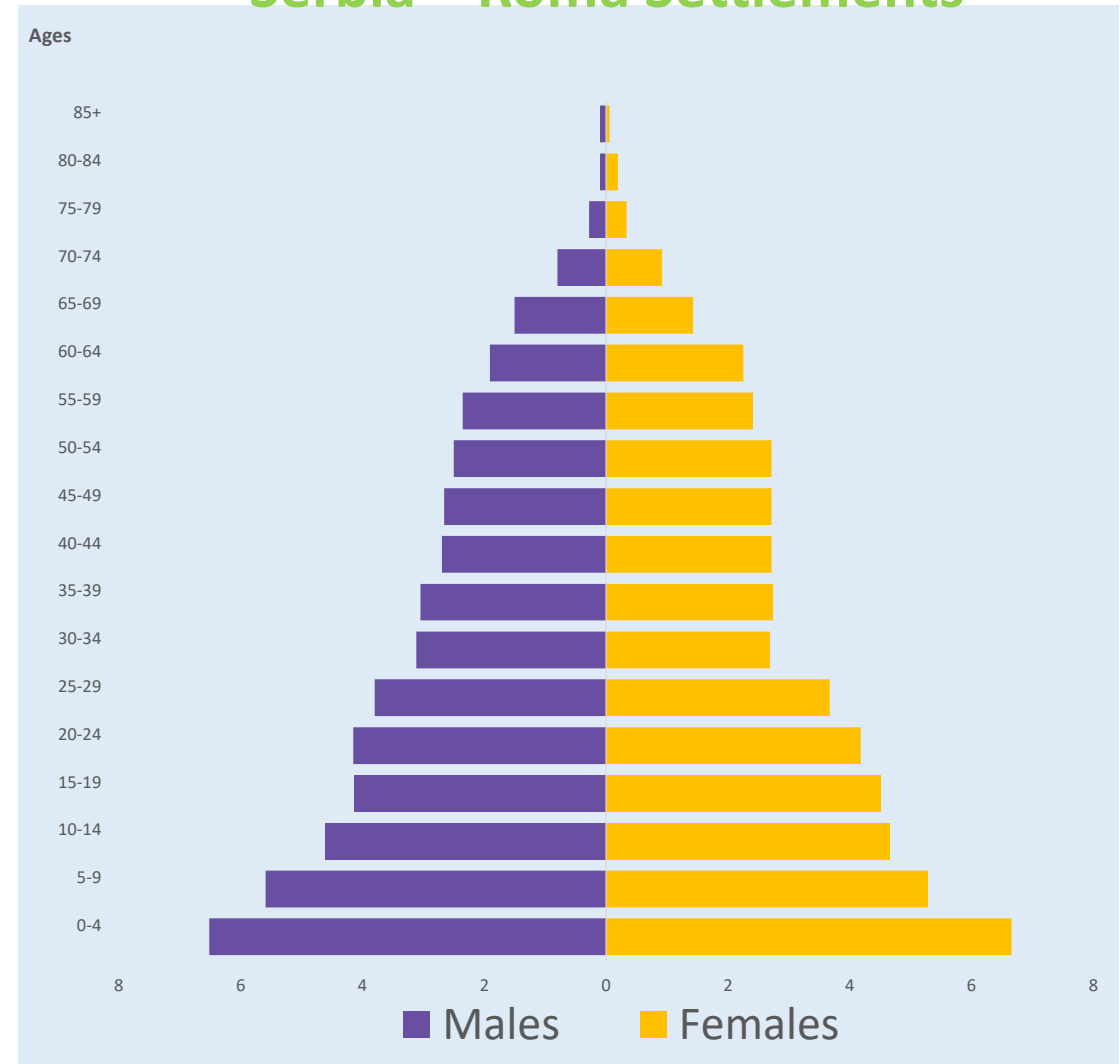

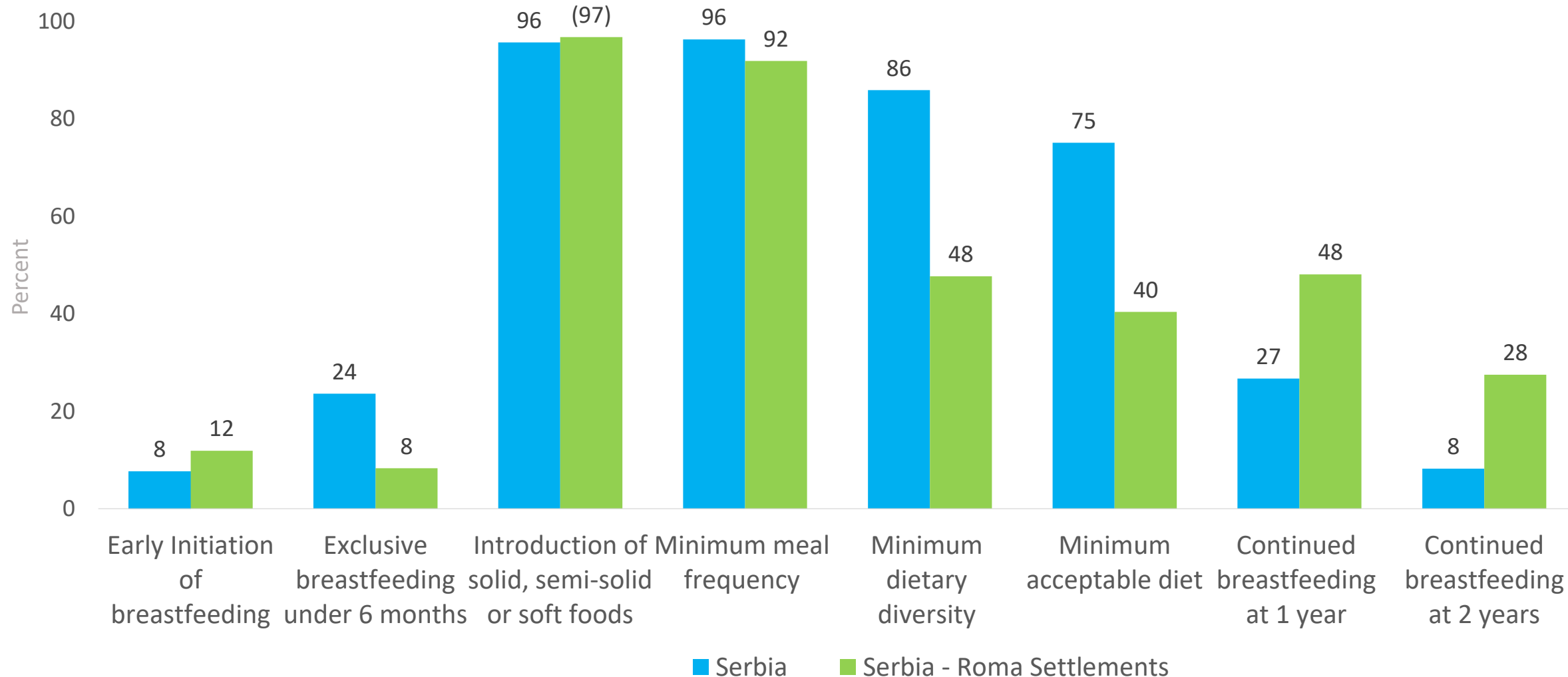

Trends in under-5 mortality rates

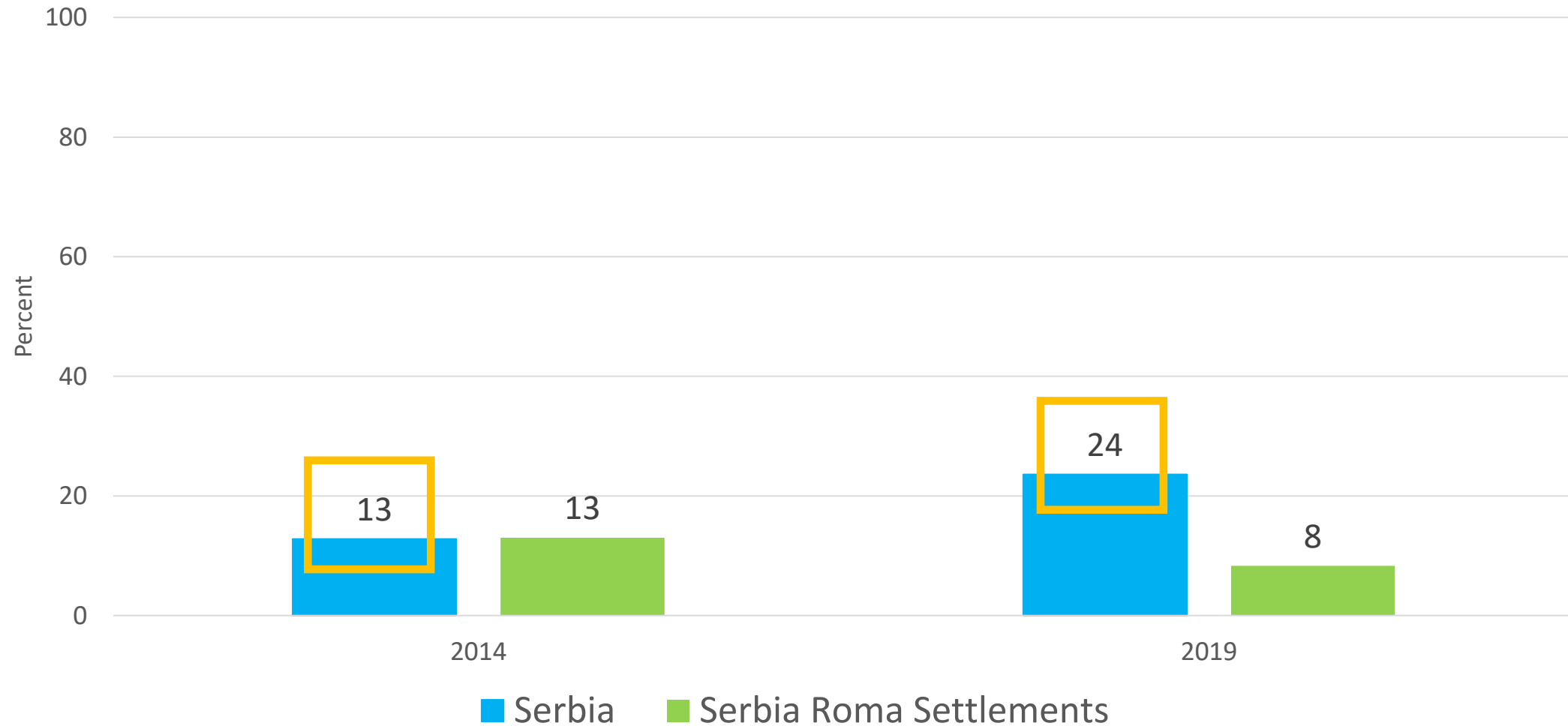


Infant and young child feeding

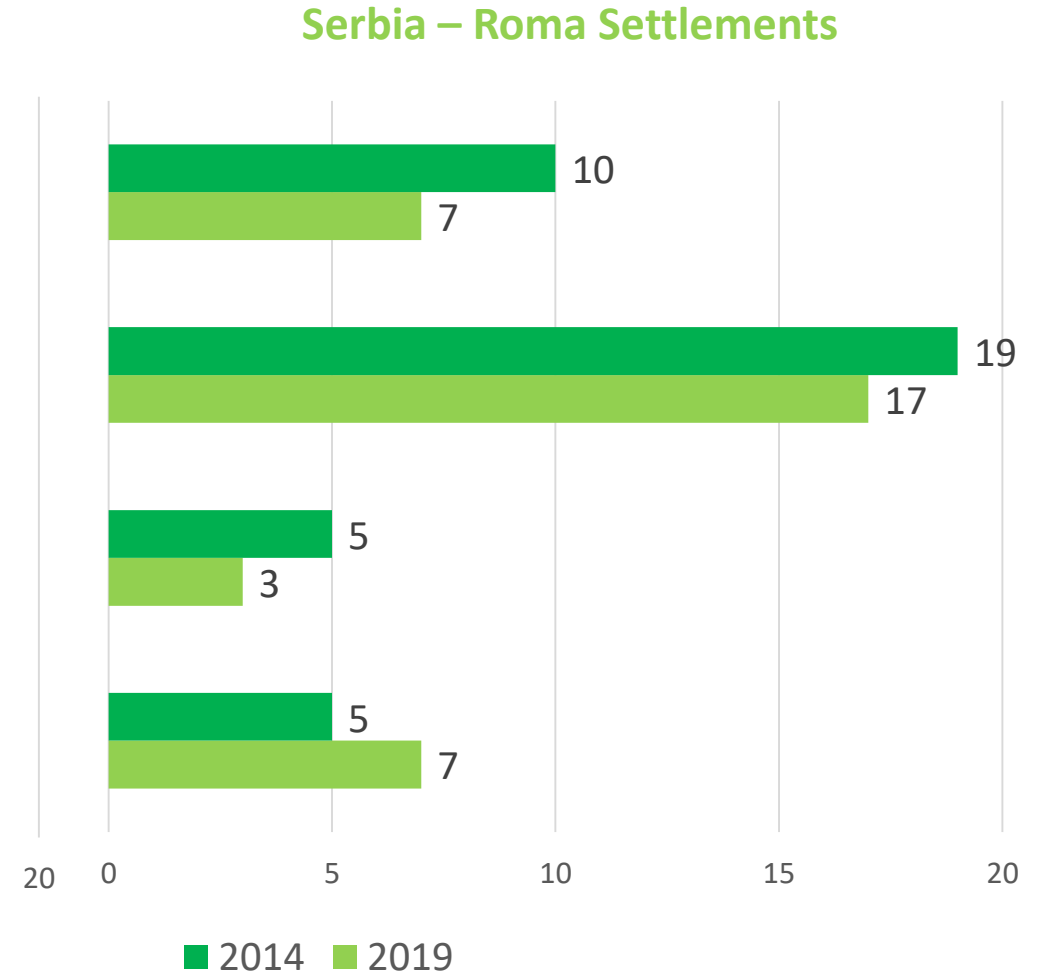
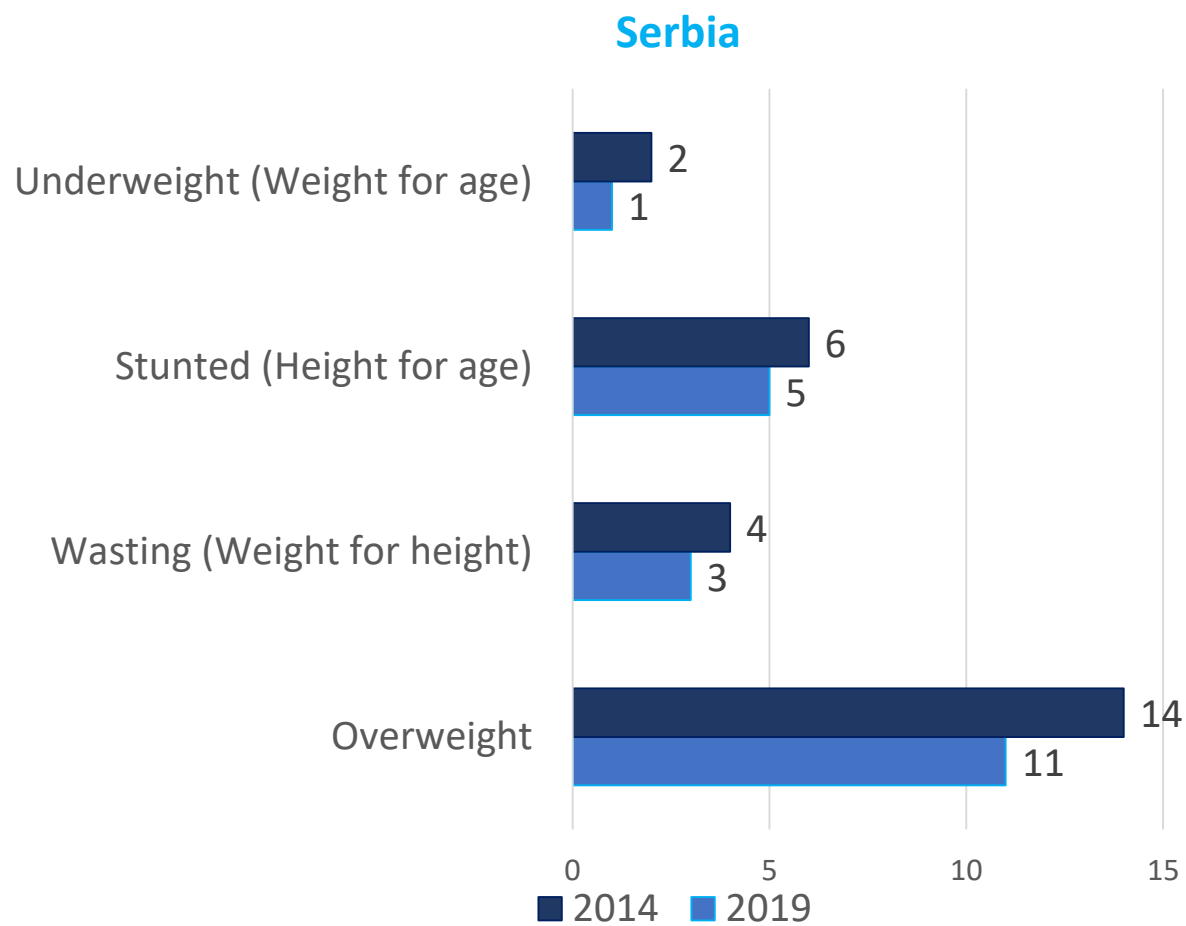
Exclusive breastfeeding under 6 months



Nutritional status of children (under 5)

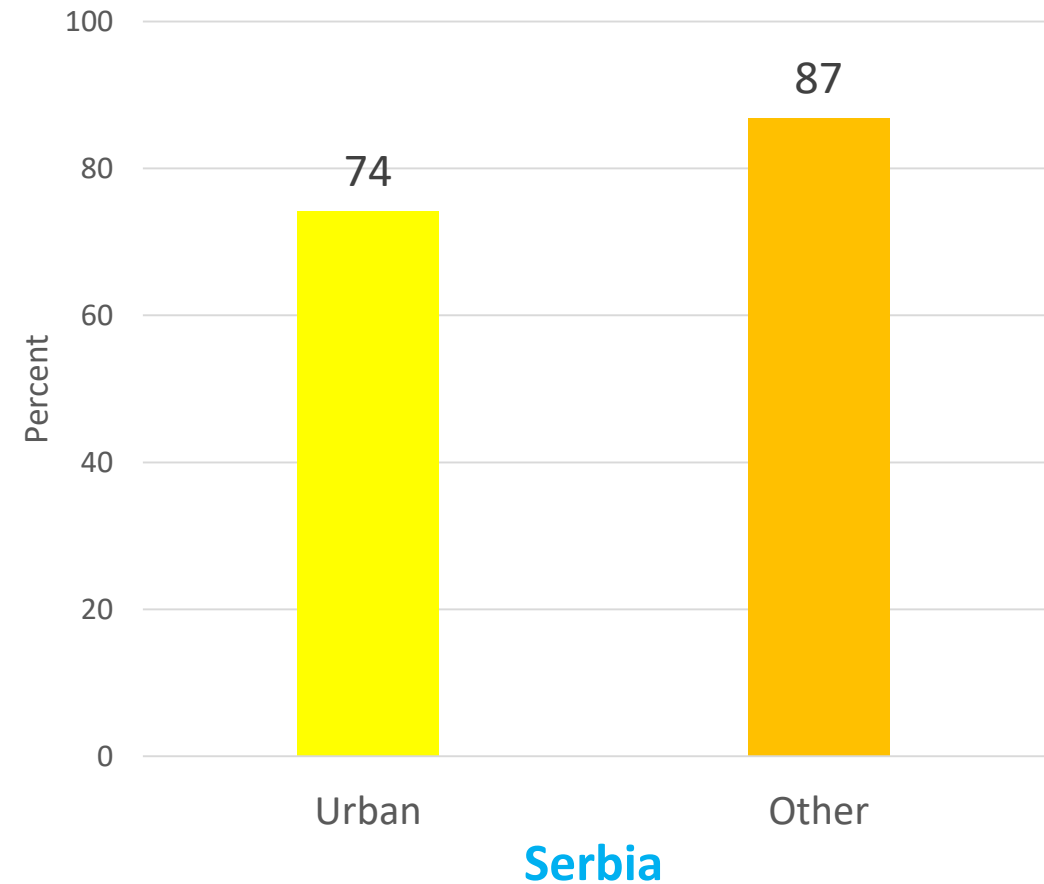
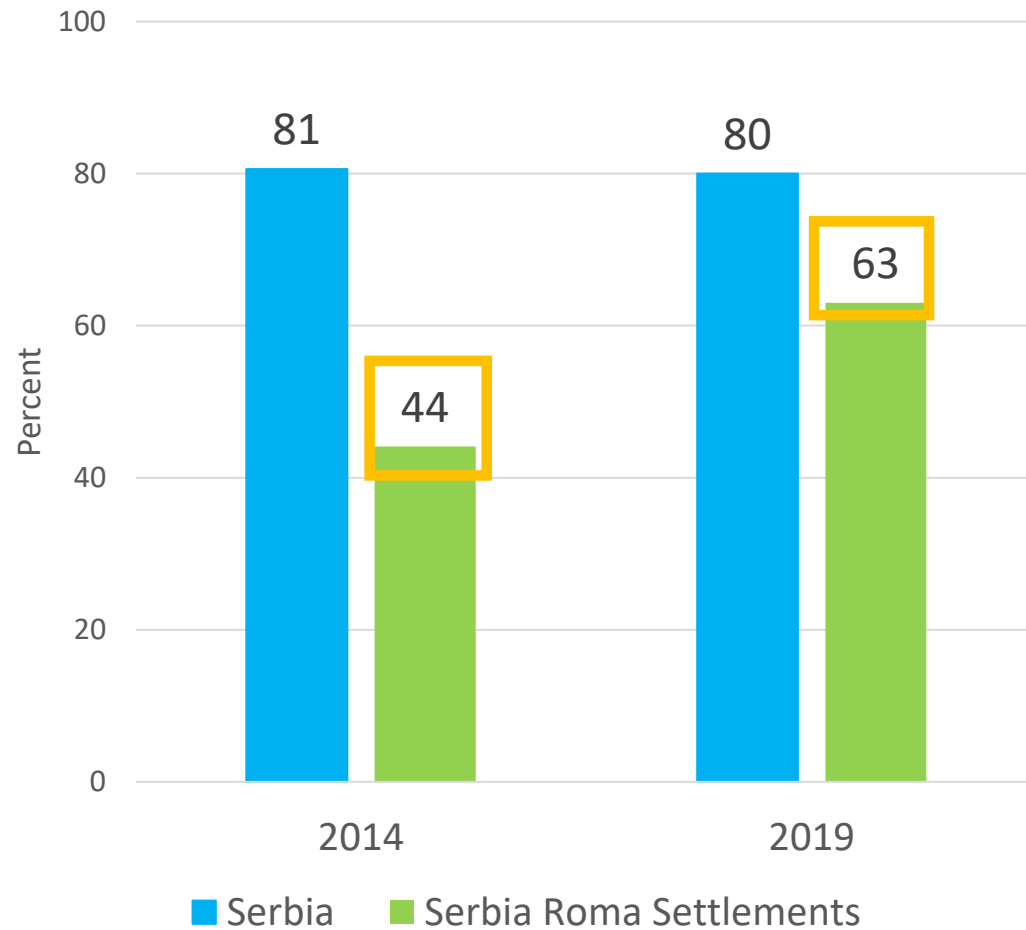

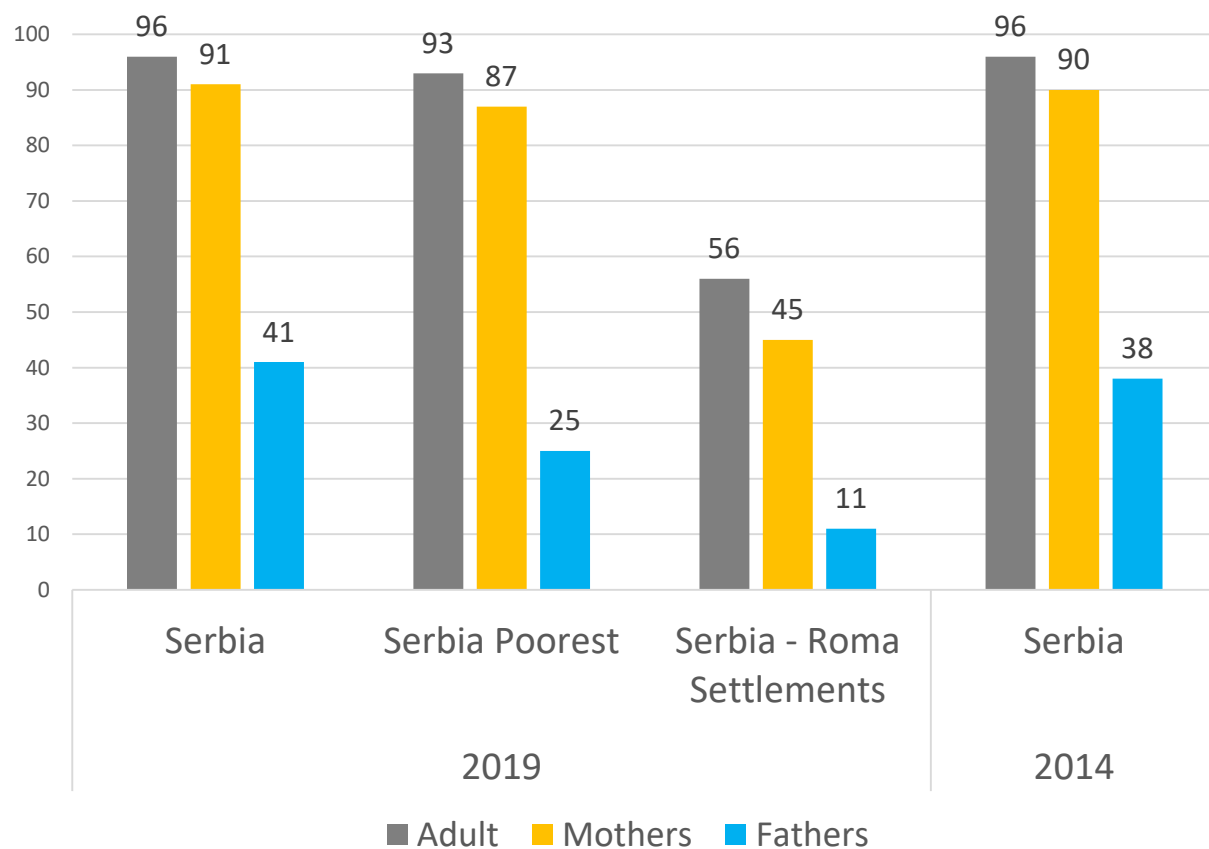

Full immunization coverage excluding PCV and revaccines

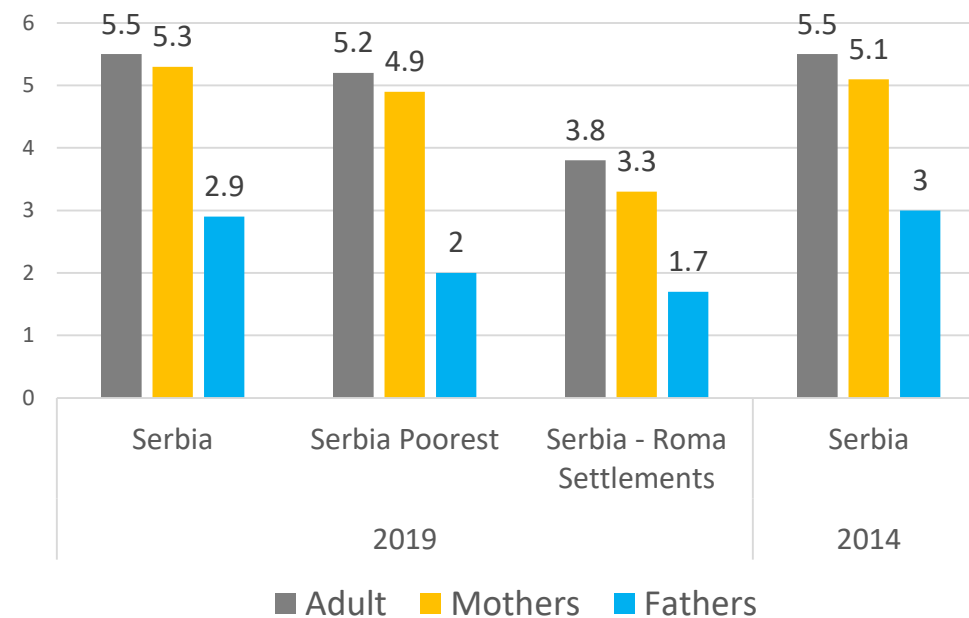


Support for learning (children aged 2–4 years)

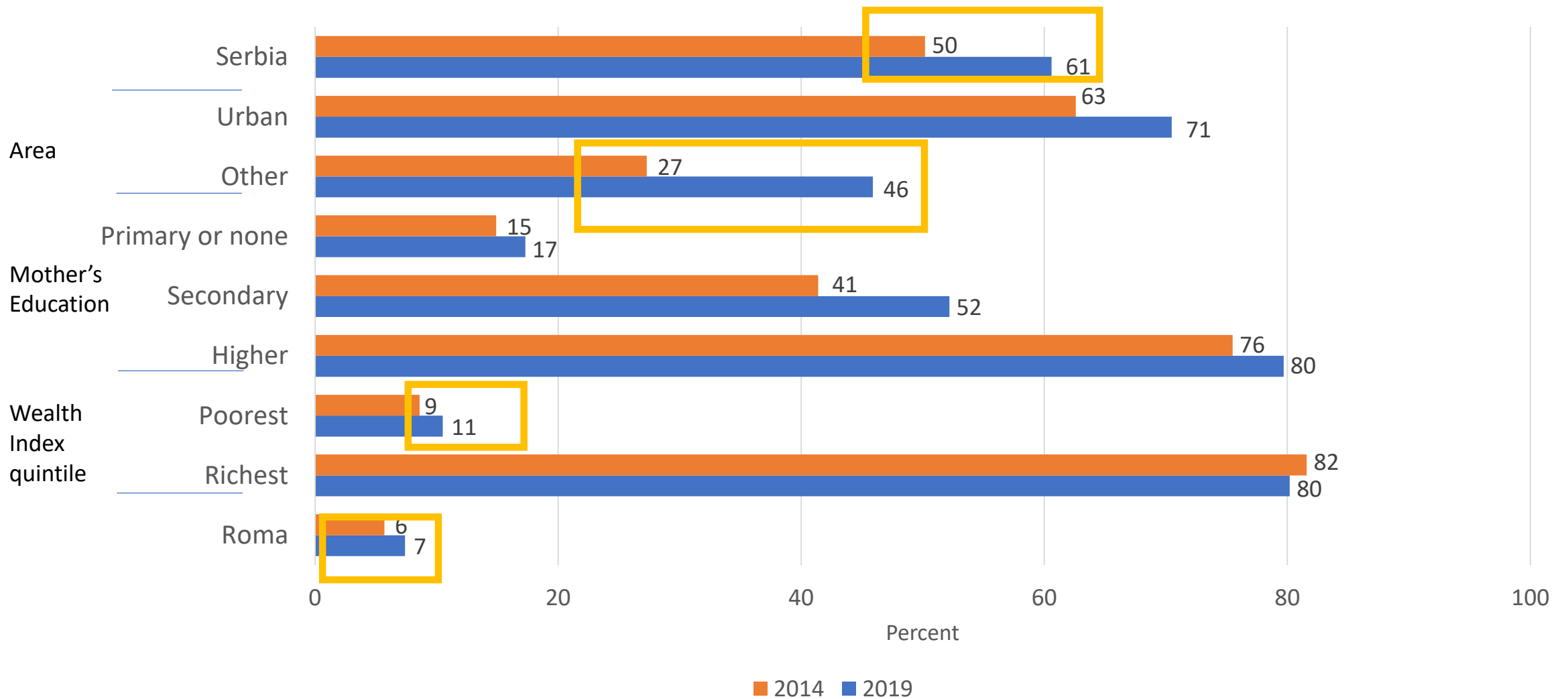
Participation of adults, mothers and fathers in activities that stimulate learning



Mean number of activities



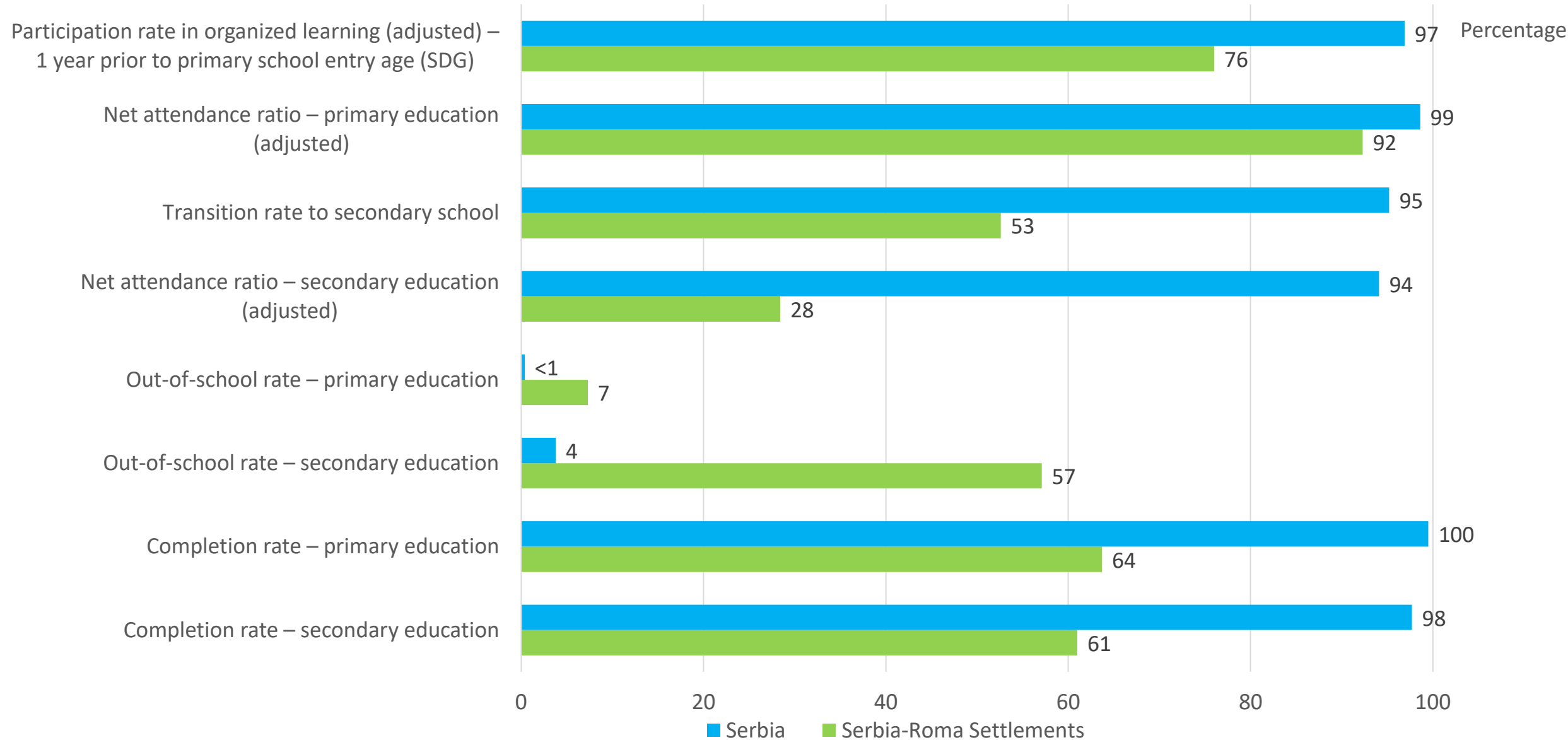
Attendance to an early childhood education programme (aged 3–5 years)



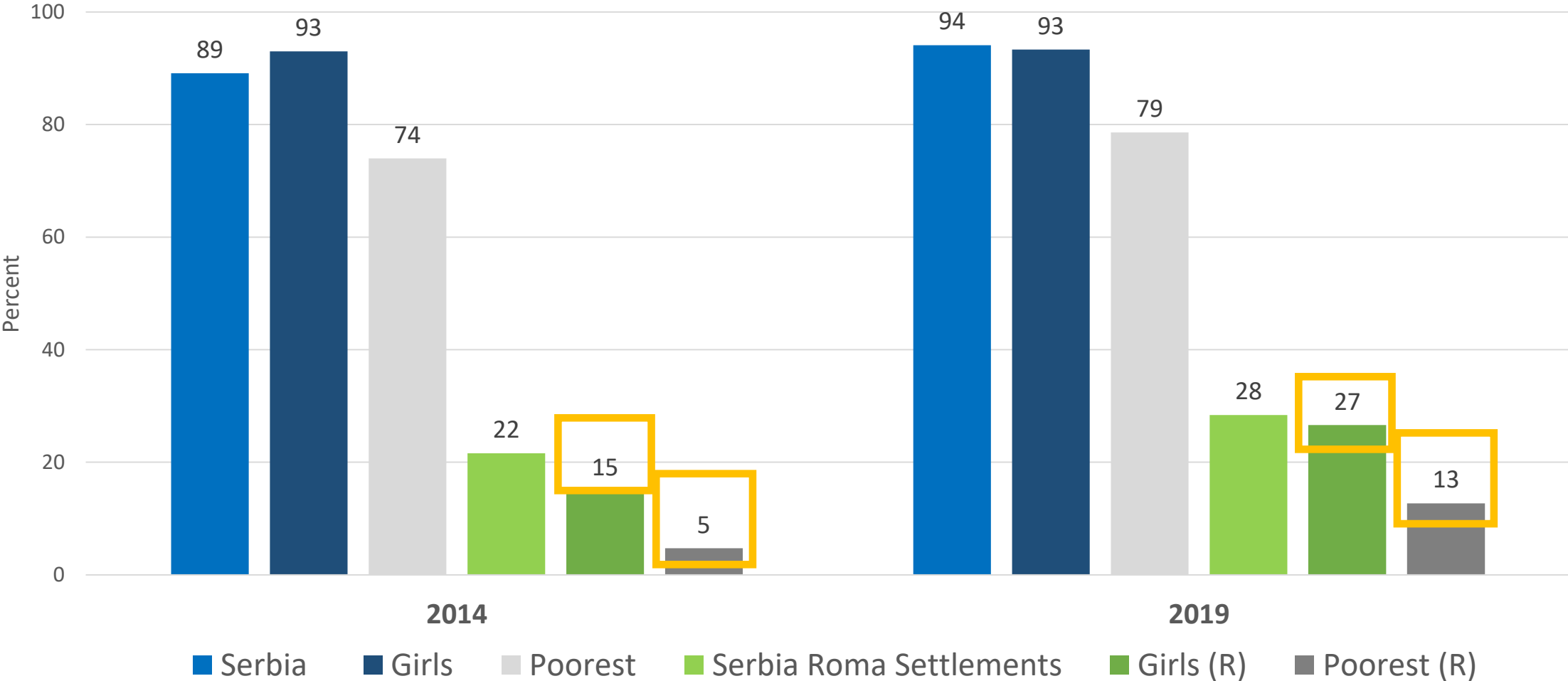

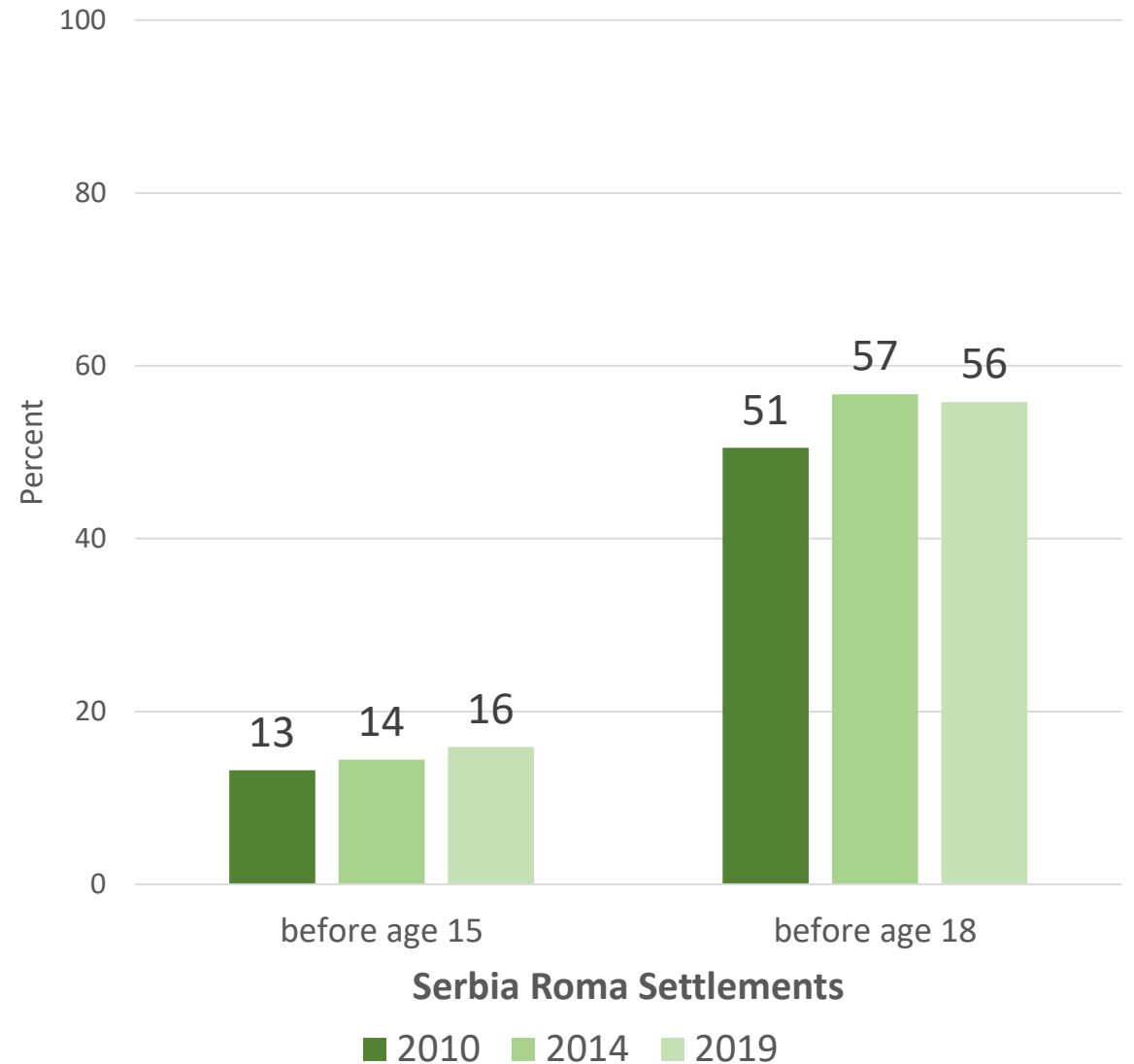
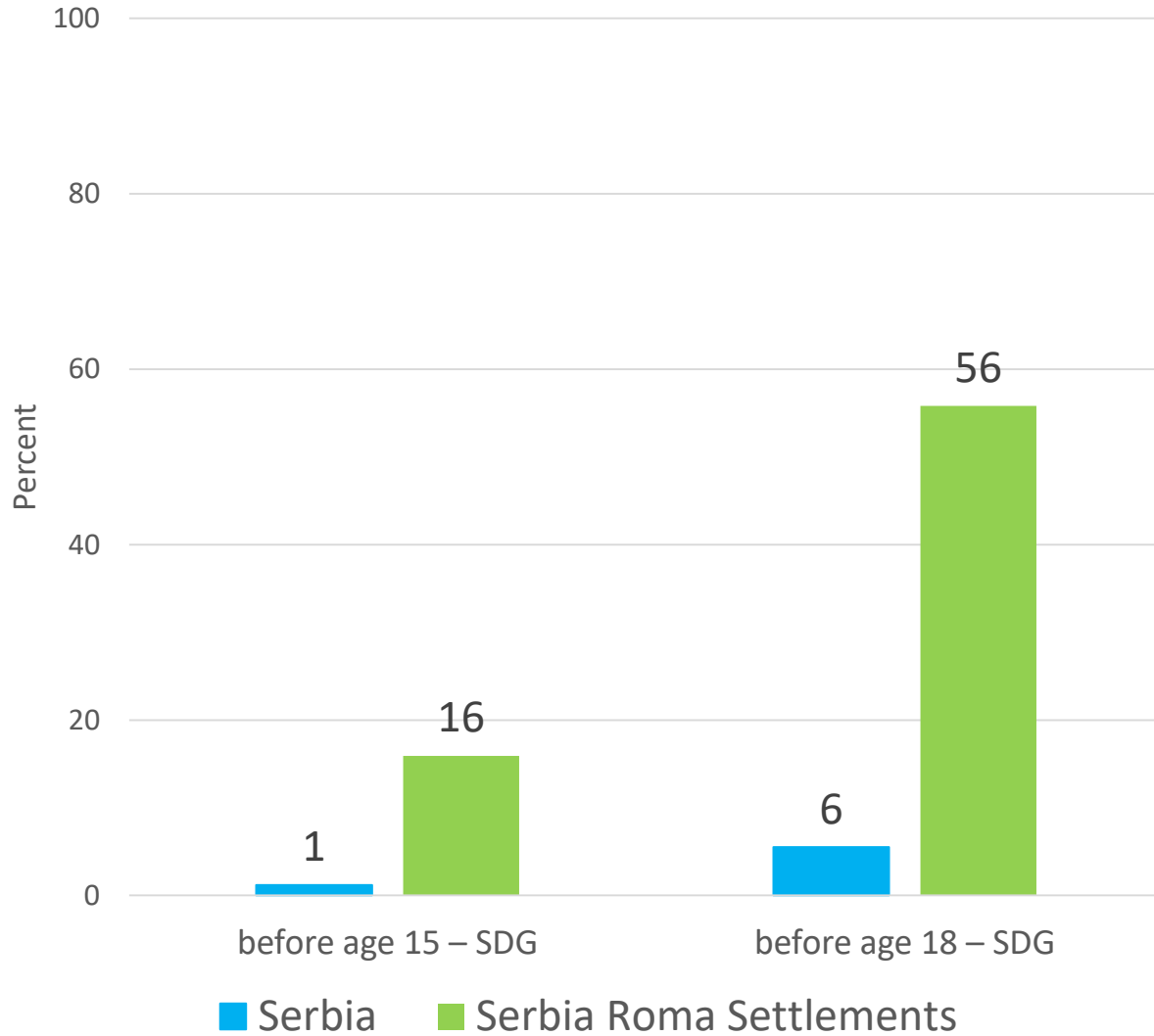


Net attendance in secondary education



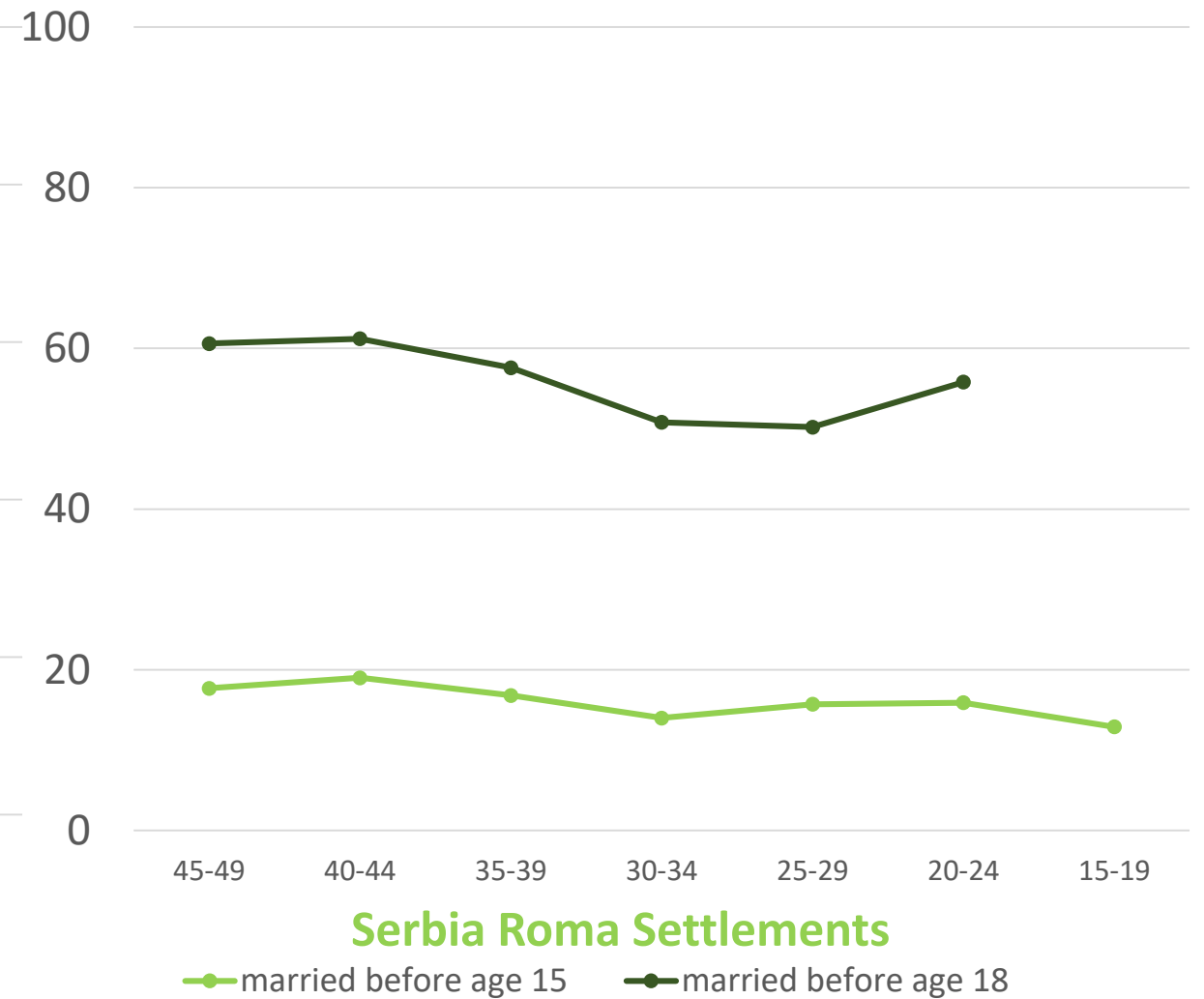
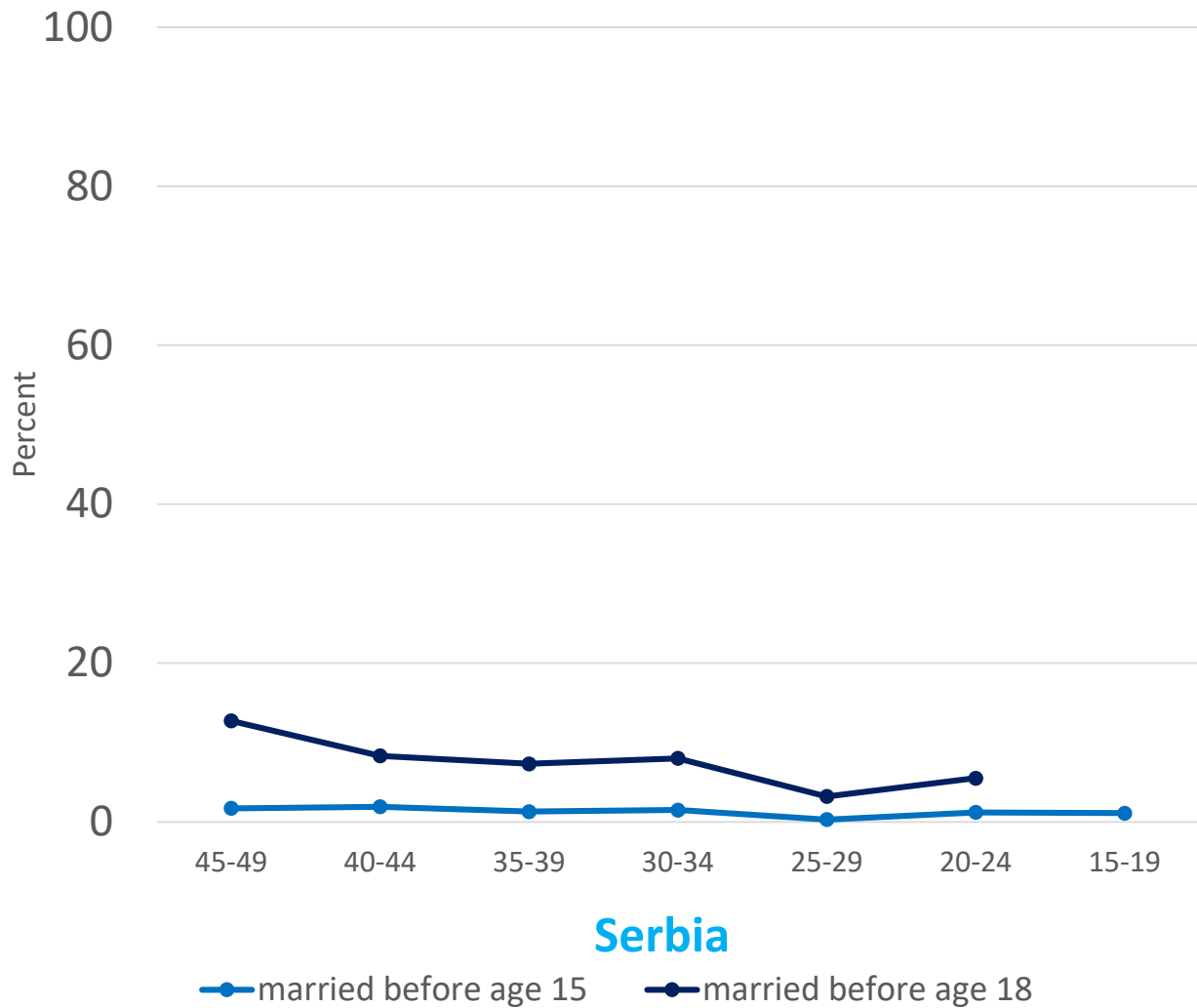

Women by age groups in years

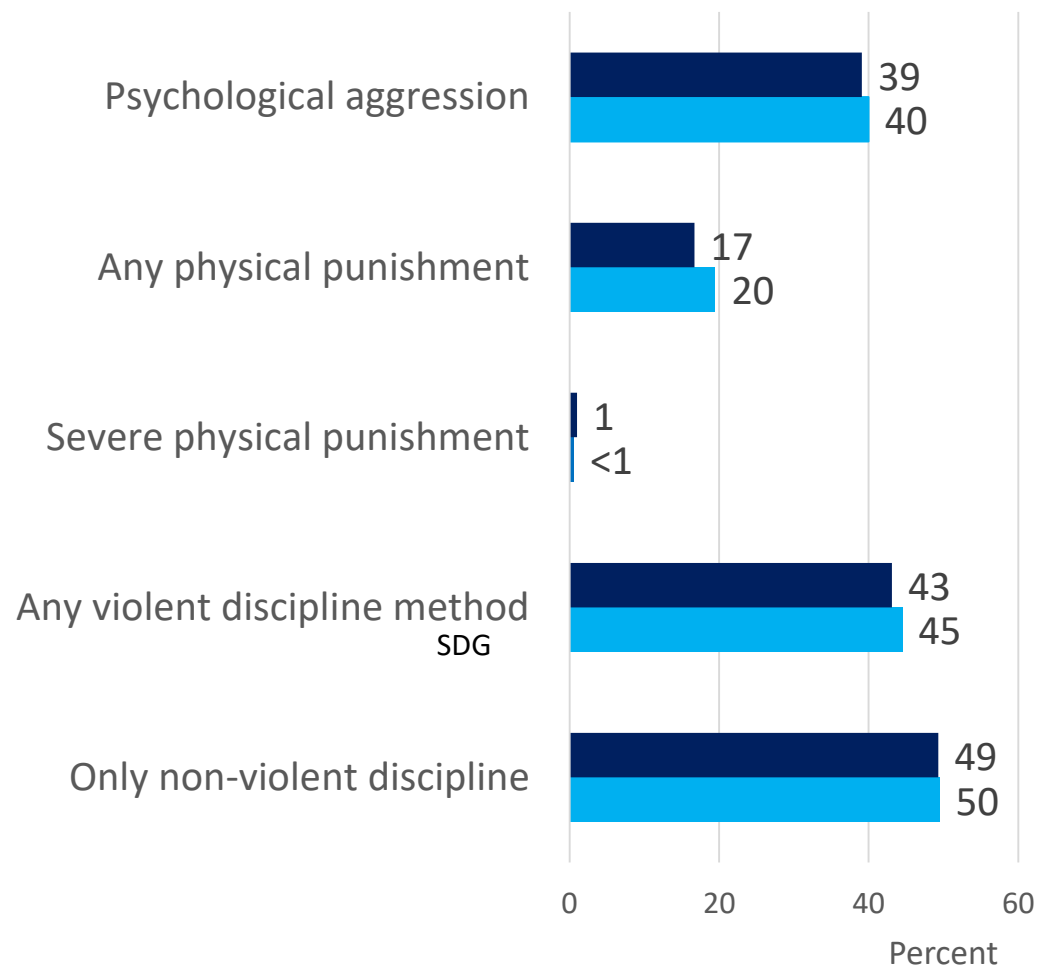


Child disciplining methods (children age 1–14 years)

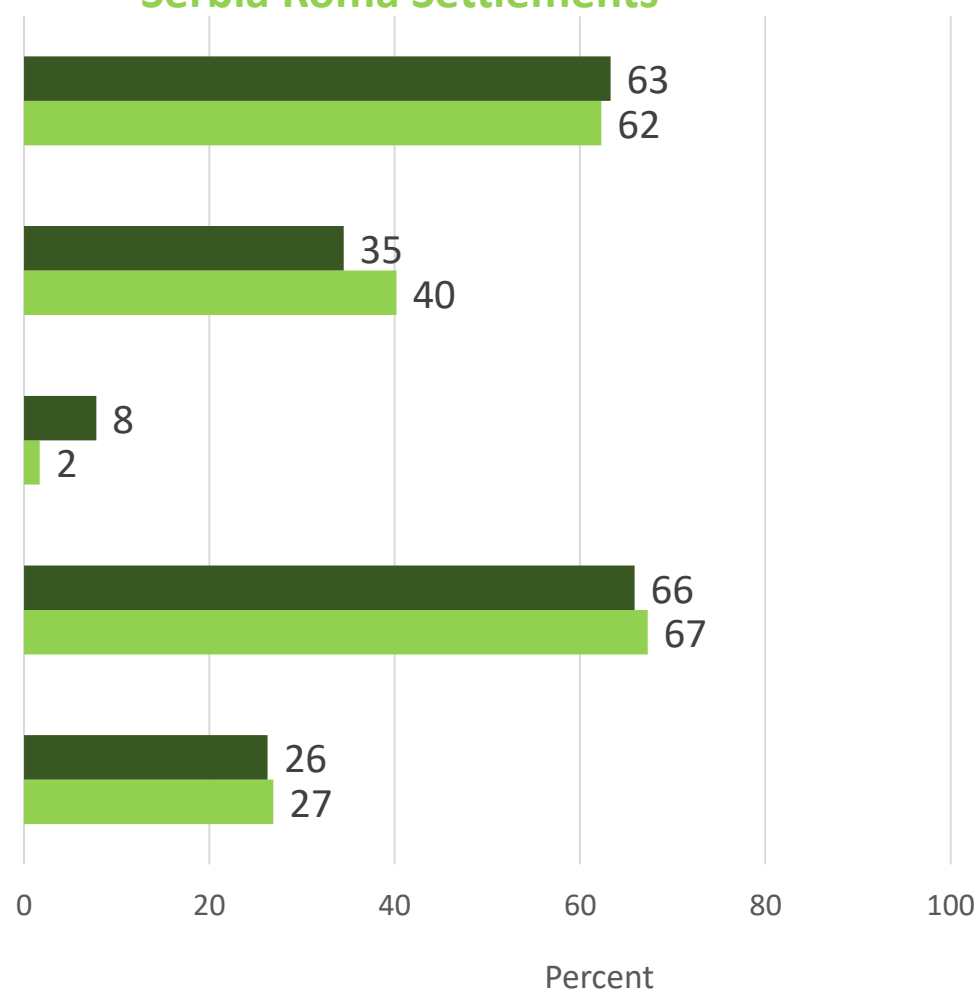

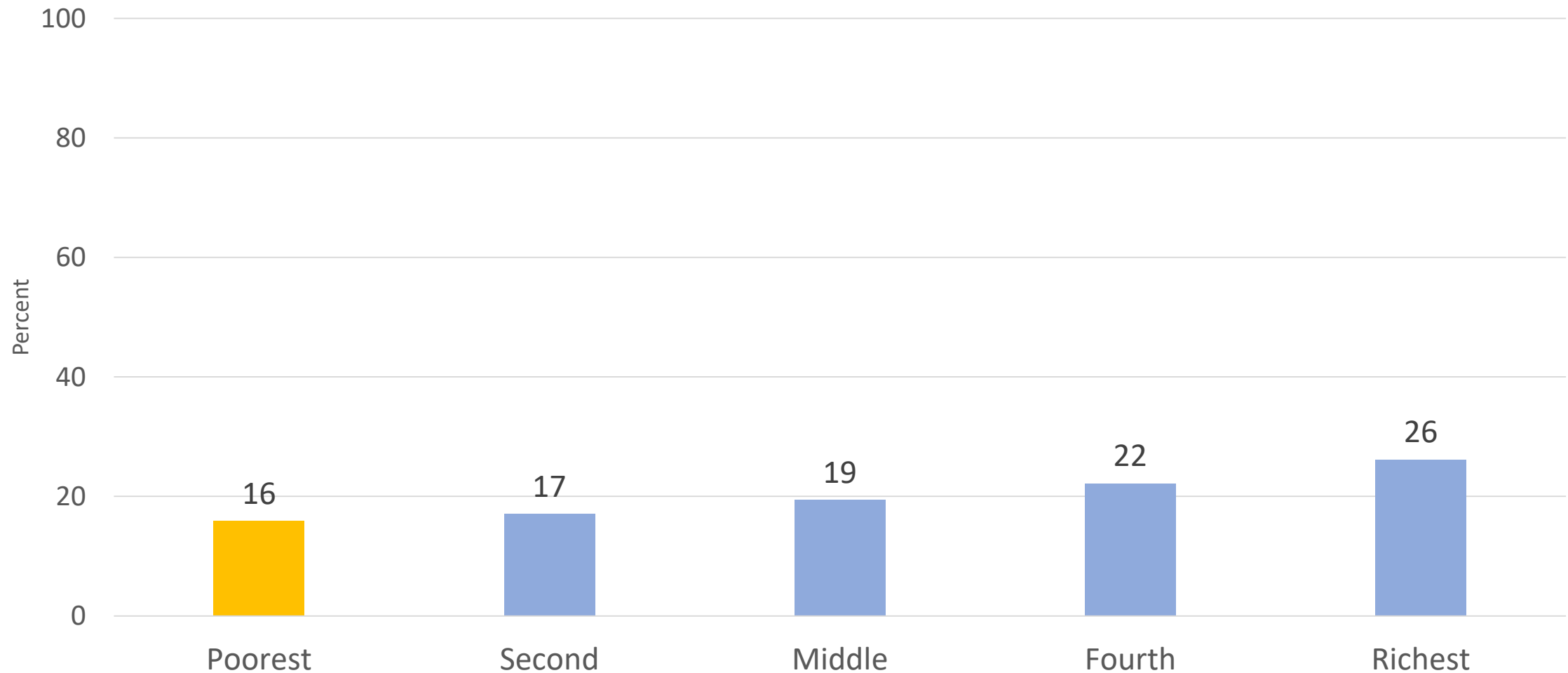

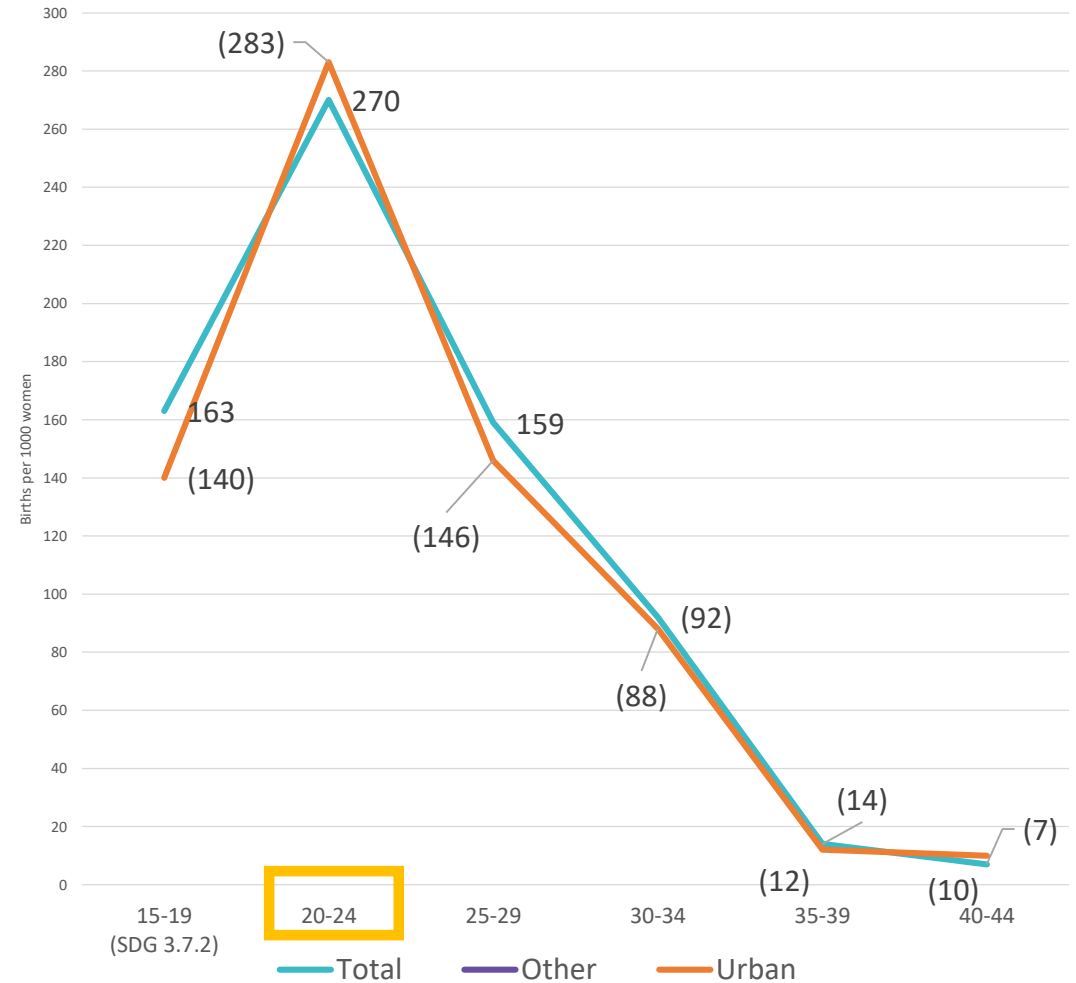

Age-specific fertility rate for women aged 15–19 years: SDG 3.7.2

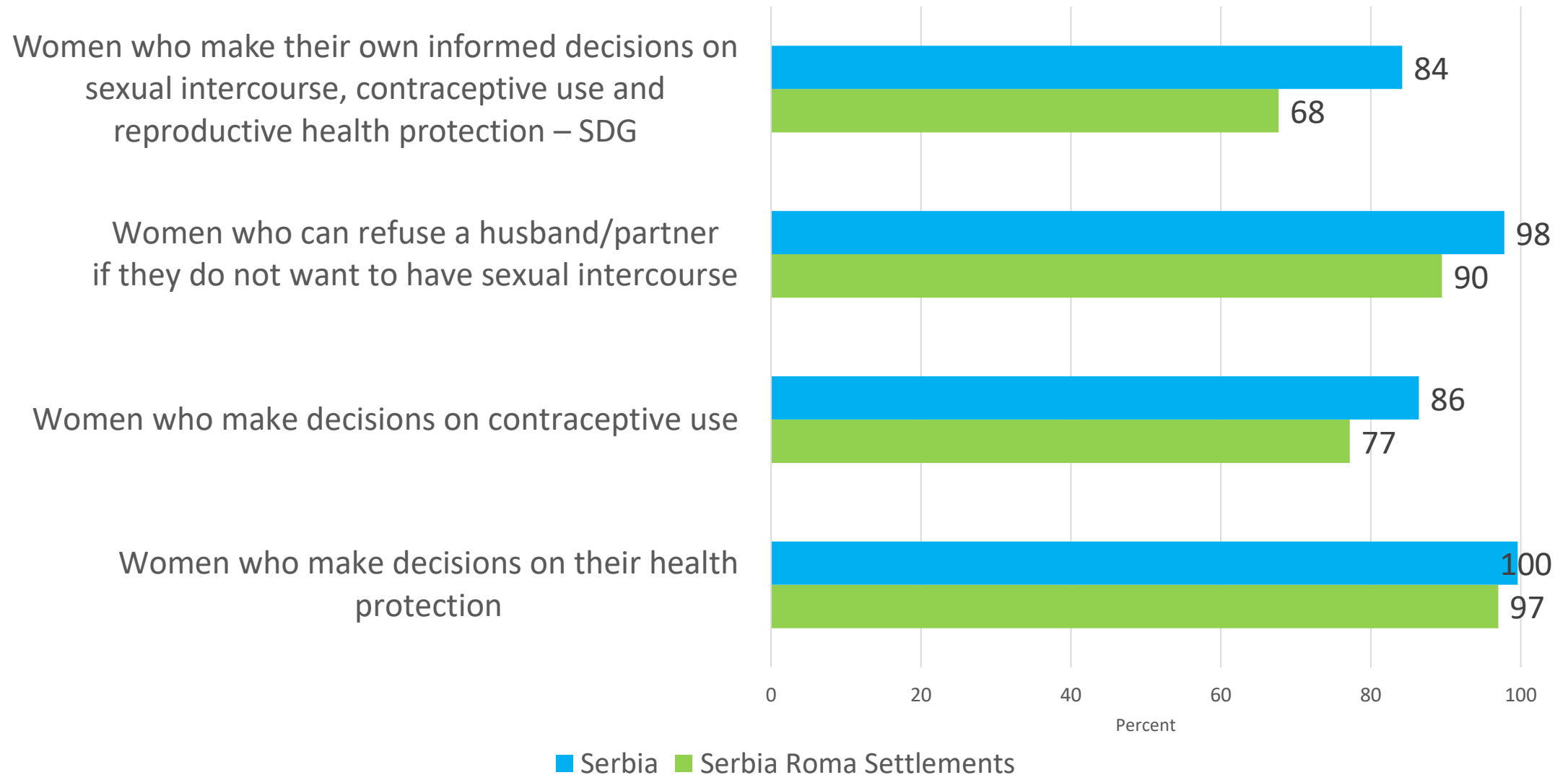


Age Specific Fertility Rates

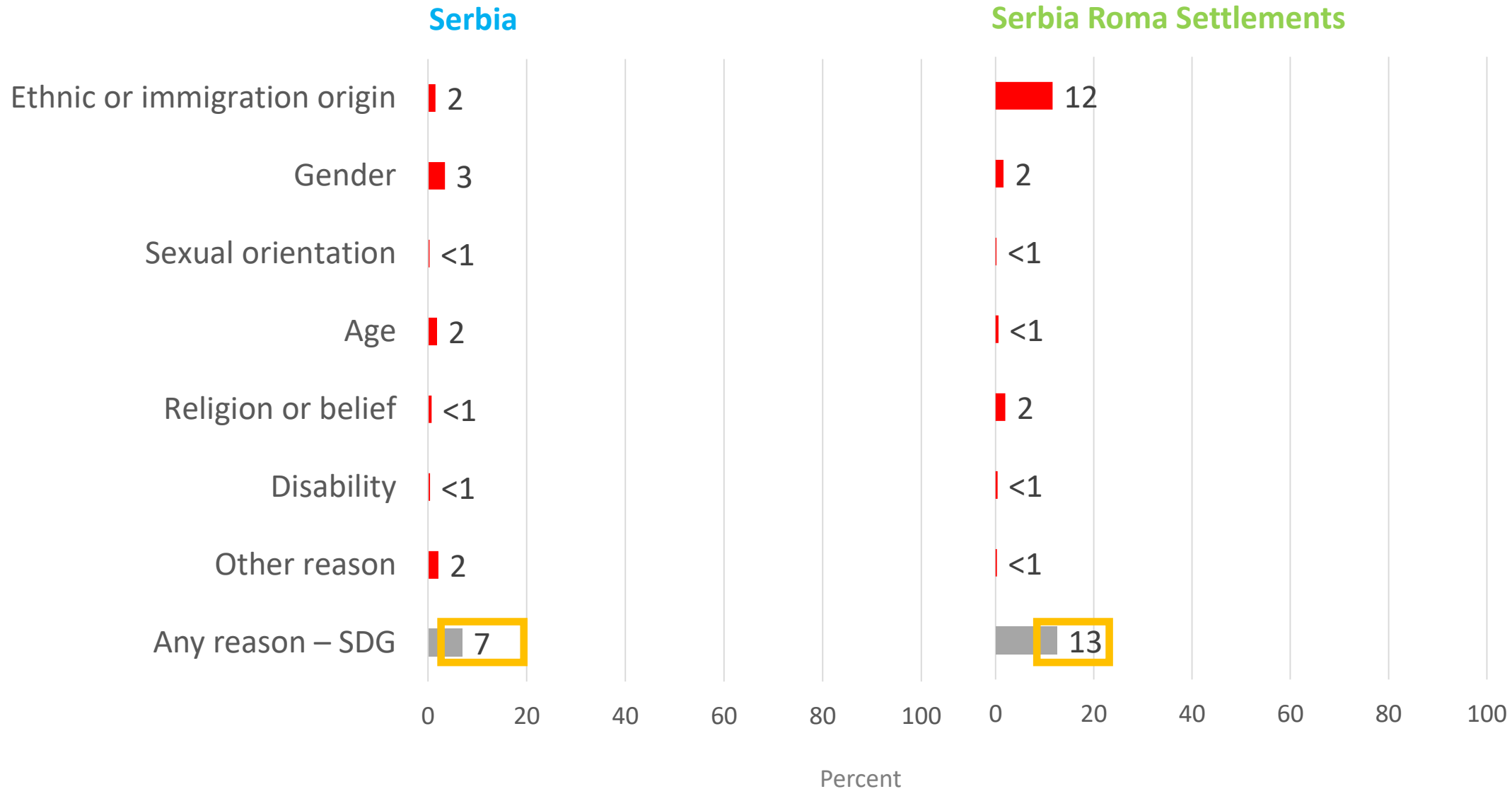

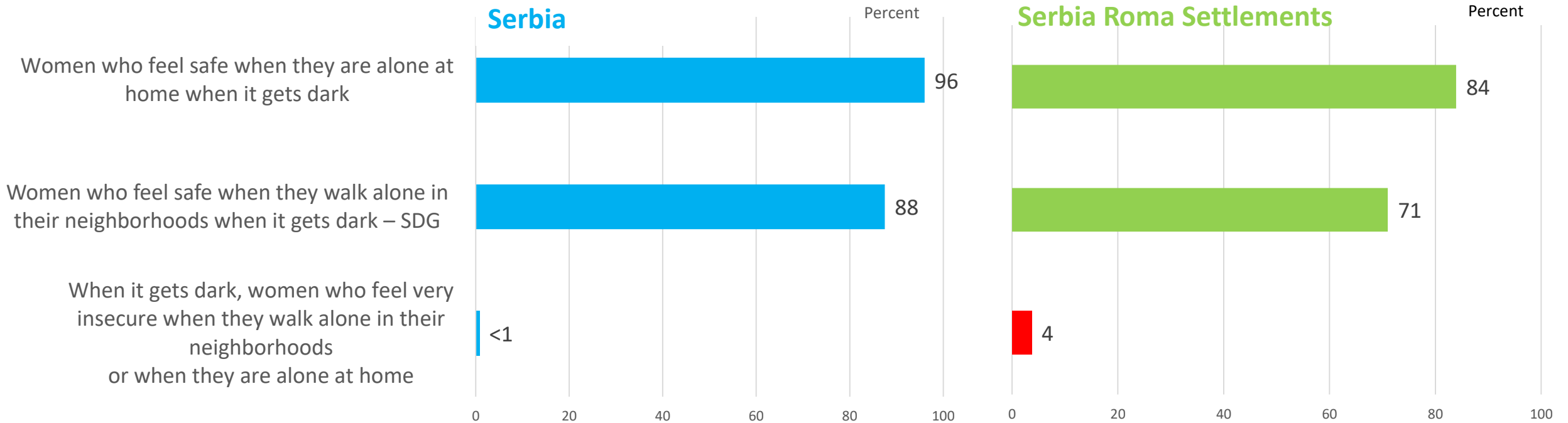

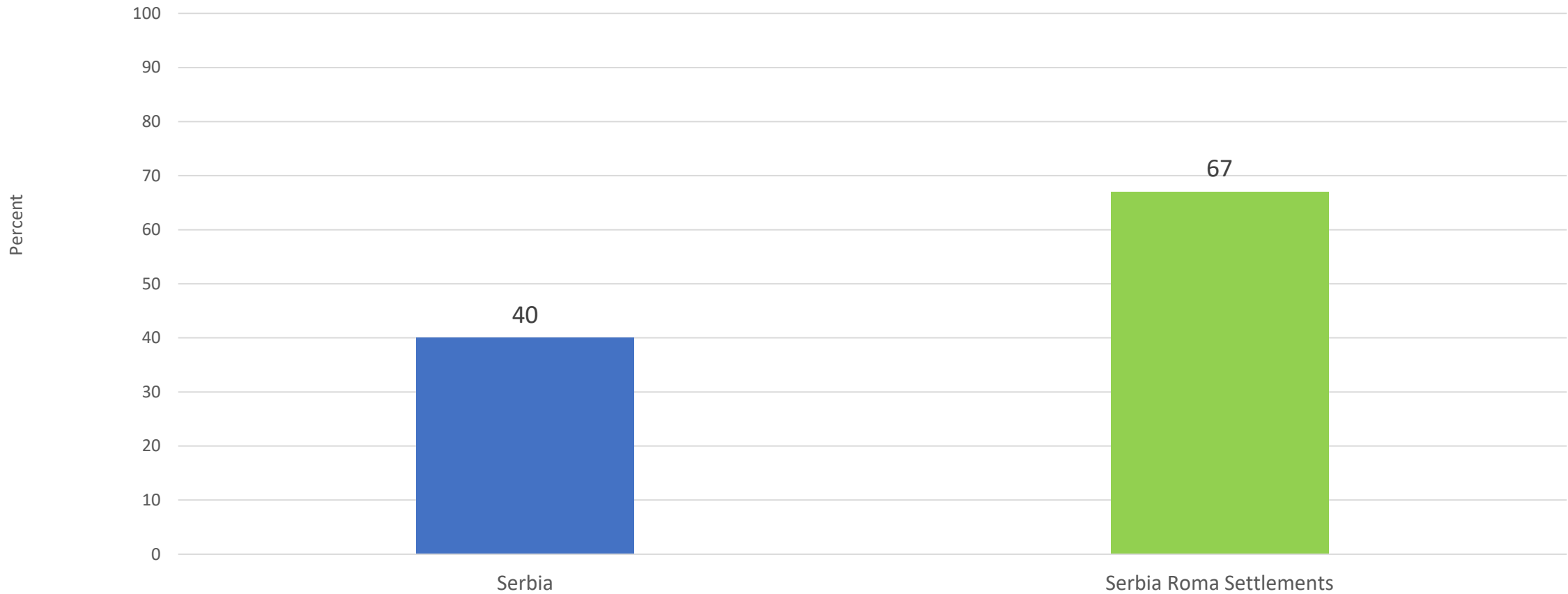

Sense of security: SDG 16.1.4



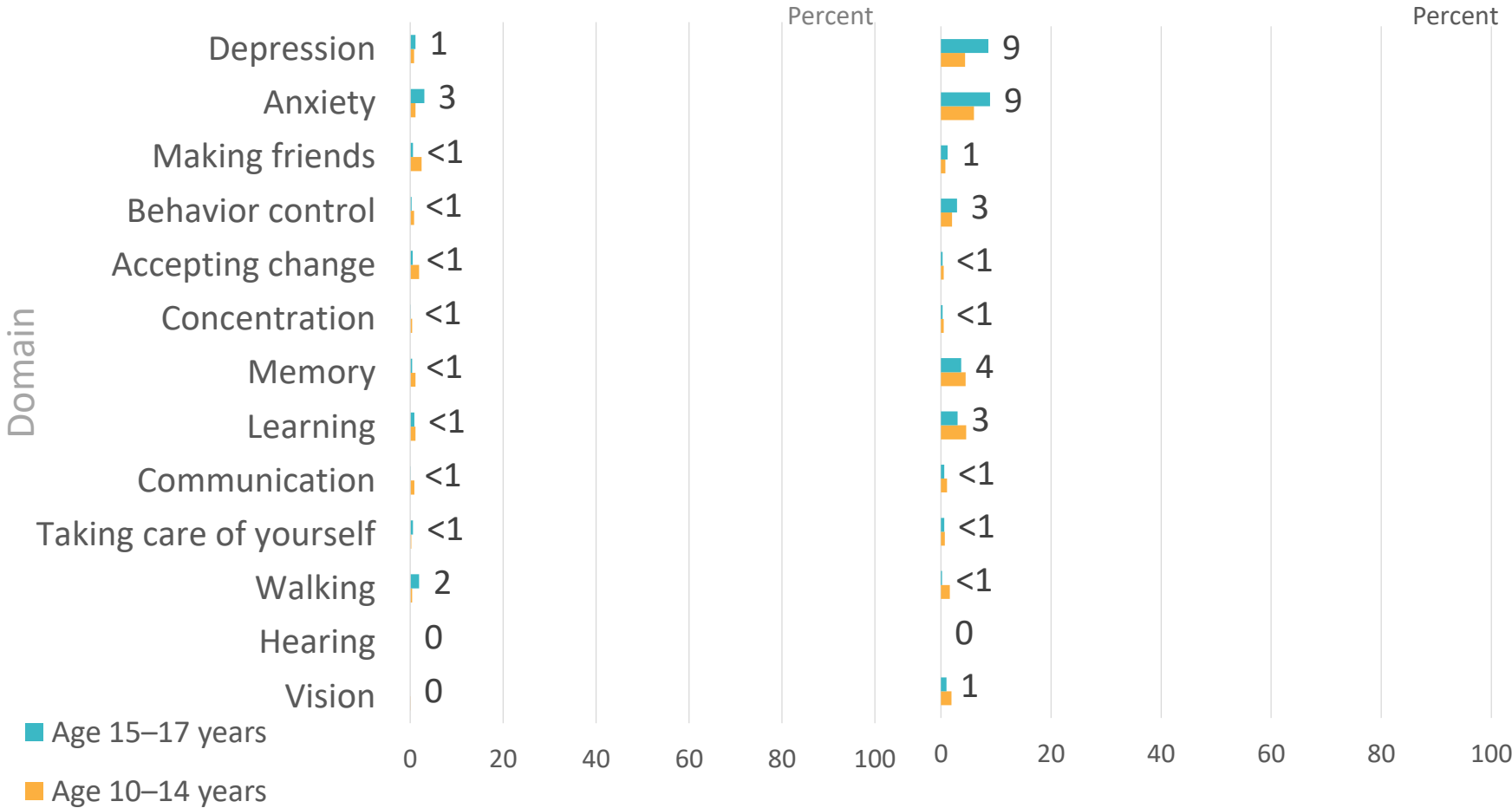

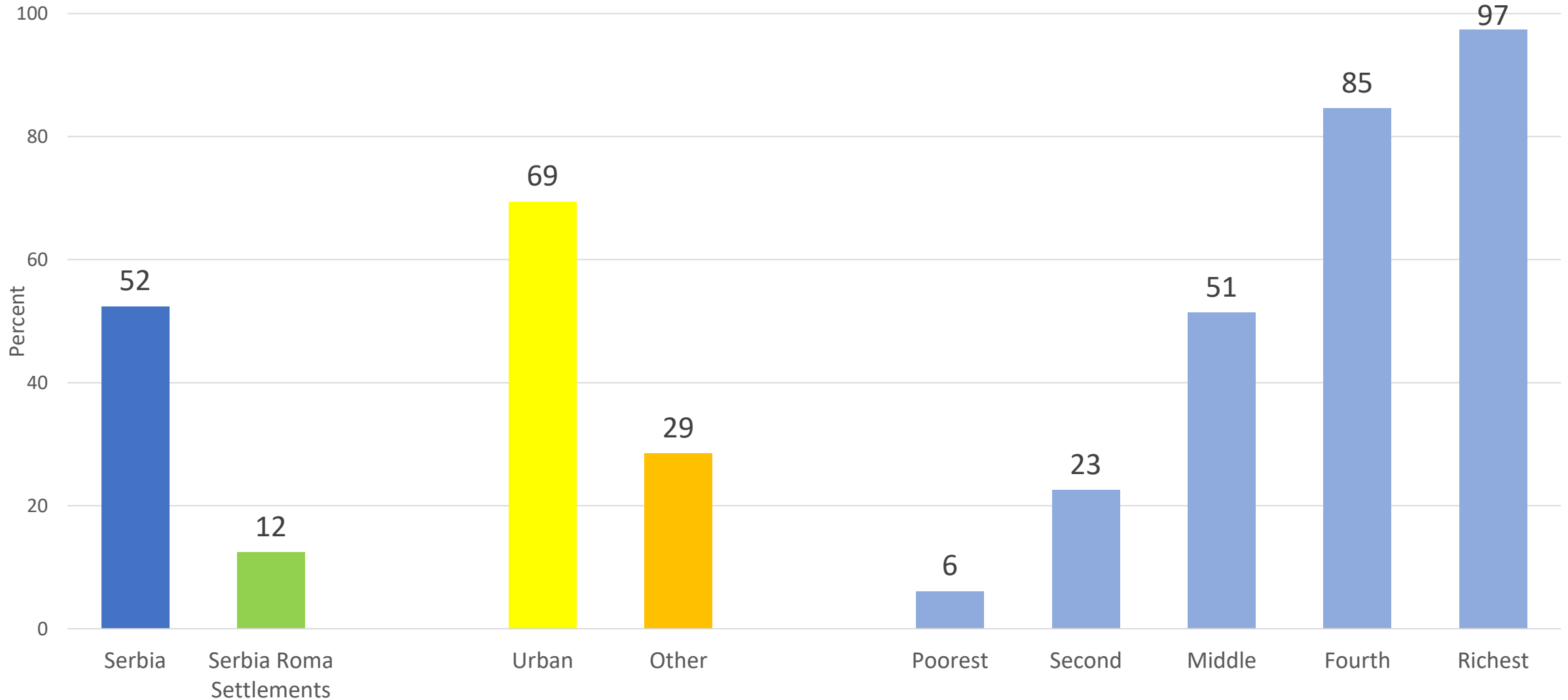
